Investment Strategy

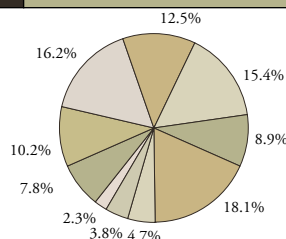
LSV uses a quantitative investment model that ranks securities based on fundamental measures of value (price to-earnings ratio) and recent indicators of recovery (recent price appreciation). Although the Fund is managed conservatively relative to its benchmark, the S&P 500 Index, the Fund will be subject to a similar degree of volatility as its index, which has been high at times over historical periods. It is expected to experience a low level of portfolio turnover.
